### **Tractor Thefts Fuel Big Jump in Rural Crime**

RURAL crime is on the rise, led by a sharp increase in the theft of expensive tractors, new data published today shows.

Rural insurer NFU Mutual's claims figures show the number of farm machinery thefts across the UK rose by 5.5 per cent in 2009. It estimated the machinery thefts cost the industry £42.2 million alone in 2009, compared with £30.3m in 2008.

The trend is being driven by a significant increase over the last two years in the number of tractors being stolen 'to order', often for immediate export from channel ports to destinations including Africa, Eastern Europe and the Middle East.

In a recent survey, 70 per cent of NFU Mutual's 300 branch offices reported an increase in rural crime in their area, compared to the same period in 2009. Only 7 per cent said crime had decreased, while 23 per cent reported the same level as 2009.

Asked whether crimes were opportunistic or planned, 71 per cent of branches said they believed rural crime was planned.

NFU Mutual chief claims manager, John Kenny, said: "It's disappointing to see that rural crime is on the increase and that rural homes and businesses have become a source of rich pickings for thieves.

"This year's survey highlights the importance of good security measures and vigilance in the battle against rural crime."

The insurer's survey also highlighted a number of emerging trends, demonstrating the changing nature of rural crime – from sporadic incidences of opportunist thefts to highly organised thefts relying on detailed surveillance and planning. It has provided further details to help farmers protect themselves against crime.

***How the thieves operate...***

**STRIP AND SHIP**

These vehicles are being taken from fields, driveways and car parks and quickly stored in warehouses, where they are often stripped down to their component parts and shipped overseas to Eastern Europe and the developing world to meet the demand for parts.

**LUNCHTIME LOOTERS**

Sneaky thieves are pouncing when farmers and gardeners return to the house for lunch, searching unlocked tool workshops and sheds for chain saws, hedge-trimmers and other expensive power tools.

**HIDE AND SEEK**

Where thieves suspect tractors, quad bikes or motor vehicles are fitted with tracker devices they will often hide them in a remote area to see if the item is recovered by the police. If, within a couple of days, the stolen item has not been recovered thieves can be pretty confident it does not have a tracker device fitted.

**GOING, GOING, GONE**

Power tools and riding tack have proven to be highly desirable for thieves in the East Midlands as they are portable and easy to sell on. Research suggests many of these items are often sold on at car boot sales and on internet auction sites.

***What you can do to stop them...***

**LIVESTOCK**

- Ensure livestock is clearly marked
- Check stock at least daily
- If possible graze stock in fields away from easy road access
- Ask neighbours to report any suspicious sightings or sounds of distressed livestock
- Be very careful when buying stock. If you're at all suspicious of the origins of stock offered for sale - don't buy

**VEHICLES**

- Remove keys and secure cars, tractors, and other vehicles when unattended
- Use security lighting in yards and drives
- Have the registration number etched on vehicle windows
- Consider CESAR security marking and/or immobilisers for more expensive vehicles
- Physically secure ATVs by means of suitable locking devices or heavy duty security chain and padlocks

**HOMES**

- Install an alarm system accredited by UKAS and use an installer certified by a recognised approval body such as NSI or SSAIB
- Fit and use insurance approved (BS3621:2004) security locks to all perimeter doors
- Fit and use window security locks on ground floor windows and accessible first floor windows
- Consider re-sitting easily accessible tanks to an area or building where they are better protected
- Use Smart Water to mark valuable possessions
- Fit security heavy-duty padlocks to garages and other outbuildings
- Don't leave valuables on view
- Secure ladders and tools out of sight
- Set timers for lights and radios when you're not at home
- Keep large sums of cash or jewellery in suitable safe protection

- Keep garden tools secure and out of sight
- Consider outside security lighting protection

Further to the above, it will be noticed as you read information in the sections below, there are certain categories of property that are being stolen which stand out.

In brief they are:-

- Land Rovers, the sort favoured by farmers, game-keepers. It matters not if they are old or new. Old ones can be broken up for spares, to be shipped abroad, new ones equally so or shipped abroad intact to reappear in Africa, Asia, Eastern Europe.
- Pedigree dogs,
- Horse Feed

Forced entry to a barn & shed. **West Mercia Update**

- Quad bike thefts have slowed down in our area. Perhaps you are putting them out of sight or securing them better? Whatever you are doing keep doing it as it's working.
- There have been some stolen tractors but not in our area - don't forget we are bordered with Gloucestershire Constabulary so they may have had thefts but we are doing well at the moment. I know the tractor dealerships and makers are doing lots of work with crime prevention teams to make them more secure, but anything you can do decreases the risk of theft further.
- Surprisingly I looked at the figures for stolen Land Rover Defenders - nationwide there have been 289 this year! All ages are vulnerable. Some are stolen with keys following a house burglary, some are stolen from the side of the road when the vehicle is unattended and you may be checking stock etc. Please try to reduce the risk by taking the keys out.
- Diesel thefts are still ongoing but mainly in commercial premises where there is the opportunity to steal a lot. Nothing recorded locally.
- Staddle stones:- Many of these are being stolen to order and thefts have occurred in all the villages around us here in Broadway. Some are being taken to reclamation yards. If you have some please can you consider making an identifiable mark underneath the top part of the stone, even if you just put a circle of paint, or score your initials in them. This way, if we recover some, we can tell where and who they have been stolen from. It will probably decrease the value of them but most of you aren't interested in selling them anyway.
- There have been no reported stolen horses from West Mercia that I am aware of, although nationwide there are some reported thefts. These are mainly coloured horses or Shetlands. There have been a few tack room burglaries but again nothing locally.
